For 50 years Esperança, an established 501c3 charity, has been serving the most vulnerable communities around the world, improving health and providing hope. This is seen most drastically through Esperança's surgical missions. Teams of medical volunteers pay for all their expenses, and travel to Nicaragua, Peru or Ecuador to provide a week's worth

of life-saving surgeries. Here, complicated surgeries to correct childhood deformities, which would normally cost \$30-40,000 in the United States, can be done for an average of \$120.

The San Diego bridge community has been supporting Esperança's surgical missions for the past 8 years. Many of you know about San Diego's once-a-year fundraiser for Dr. Ray

Sachs' medical missions. Ray, a dedicated Unit 539 member, and his team, pay their own airfare, hotel, food and all their expenses. 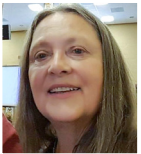

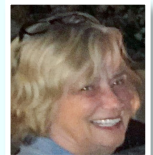

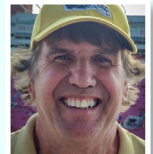
